Maverick Coaching Staff

Head Coach: Chris Hanks

Coach Hanks has been the head coach at Mesa State for the past ten years compiling a .664 winning percentage. As head coach, Hanks' Mavericks have won five conference titles and have appeared in the NCAA National Tournament six times. Prior to coaching, Hanks was a member of the Boston Red Sox and Detroit Tigers organizations.

Pitching Coach: Jeff Rodgers

Coach Rodgers has been the pitching coach at Mesa State for the past 15 years. One of the finest pitching instructors in the region, Rodgers was the pitching coach at Colorado State before joining the Mesa State staff, and has had 11 pitchers drafted under his tenure at Mesa State.

Assistant Coach: Steve Woytek

Coach Woytek has been an assistant at Mesa State for the past eight years. While being the infield/co-hitting instructor, the Mavericks have led the nation in defense, batting average, and home runs. As a player Coach Woytek earned All-Conference, and Academic All-American honors.

Assistant Coach: Kurtis Beidleman

Coach Beidleman has been an assistant for the past six years. While being the outfield coach, Mesa State has had nine All-Conference outfielders. As a player Coach Beidleman helped pitch the Mavericks to three conference titles and two NCAA National Tournaments.

Assistant Coach: Landon Wareham

Coach Wareham is in his fourth year as an assistant. While being the baserunning/co-infield coach, the Mavs have led the conference in defense and steals. As a player at Mesa state, Coach Wareham was an All-Conference and All-West Region player.
