



## Terms and Conditions of Financial Aid

By signing your award notice, you are indicating that you understand the terms and conditions listed below.

- I understand that my financial aid eligibility is determined by the financial information provided by me and that it is subject to adjustment or cancellation if errors are subsequently discovered.
- I understand that if I do not meet repayment obligations on an educational loan, or if I do not repay other financial aid funds as a result of withdrawal or adjustment to my financial aid, I will not be eligible for future financial assistance.
- I understand that in order to receive financial aid, I must be making satisfactory academic progress toward my degree. Undergraduate students must maintain the following minimum grade point averages:

Hours	GPA
1 to 15	1.70
16 to 30	1.80
31 to 45	1.90
46 +	2.00

Graduate students must maintain a minimum 3.00 GPA.

Students receiving all F's for one term will be suspended from financial aid, and Return of Title IV Funds will be applied.

- I understand that undergraduate students must enroll for and complete at least 12 credit hours each semester to be considered full-time students.
- Graduate students must enroll for and complete at least nine credit hours to be considered full-time. Audited classes do not count. Part-time students should check with the Office of Financial Aid for credit hour requirements.
- I understand that complete withdrawal from Mesa State College or dropping classes may result in repayment of all or a portion of my financial aid, and financial aid suspension.

- I understand that I must report any changes in my enrollment, residency status, or receipt of additional resources in writing to the Office of Financial Aid. Additional resources such as scholarship and vocational rehabilitation benefits may result in a reduction of my award and repayment of financial assistance advanced during the academic year.
- I understand that financial aid will not be available to students who have not graduated in their program and have exceeded the total undergraduate cumulative hours as follows:

Baccalaureate degree:	170 hours

- If I accept work-study, I understand that it is my responsibility to locate a work-study job.
- If I accept a loan, I understand that I will be required to sign a Promissory Note and complete loan counseling before my funds are disbursed. I understand I am fully responsible for repaying the loan and meeting all other terms and conditions of the loan. I understand that dropping below six credit hours any time during the semester will result in cancellation of future disbursements of the Stafford loan.
- All scholarship criteria are based on a student's individual contract. Please note that you must submit your scholarship contract to accept a scholarship. Outside scholarships are contingent upon actual funds received from the organization.
