Students are required to complete ARTE 101, Two Dimensional Design; ARTE 102, Three Dimensional Design; and ARTE 151, Basic Drawing before completing 60 credit hours. These courses are prerequisites to all upper division studio classes and must be completed by the end of your sophomore year. Only 6 credit hours of independent study count toward your degree. (See new requirements for independent study.)

Students are required to participate in exit examinations or other programs deemed necessary to comply with the college accountability requirement. All degree requirements must be completed as described above. Any exceptions or substitutions must be recommended in advance by the faculty advisor and approved by the Department Head.

123 Semester hours are required for the Bachelor of Fine Arts: Art (Leading to K12 Teacher Licensure) Degree. (40 credit hours must be earned in courses numbered 300 or higher.) 2.8 Cumulative Grade Point Average must be maintained throughout program.
