Music Camp includes five days of excellent instruction from the Music Faculty at Mesa State College. Also included in the price is a Music Camp T-Shirt; one private lesson with Mesa State faculty and Music enrichment courses. Students perform in the Music Camp Band, Choir, Orchestra, or Jazz Band. During the day students are supervised by faculty and staff. During recreational time and the evenings students are supervised by our excellent counseling staff that consists of our Music Education majors as well as residence hall staff (after 9:30 p.m.)

Directions to Camp: Mesa State College Music Camp is held in the Moss Performing Arts Center on the southeast part of campus. (on 12th street near the corner of 12th and North)

Registration: 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 8 in the Walter Walker foyer of the Moss Performing Arts Center outside the Box Office. Auditions begin at 2:15 p.m. Wait outside your audition room until there is an opening. You may put your cases in Robinson Theater and warm up.

Audition Material: Instrumentalists bring an etude, exercise from your method book or part of a solo for auditions. Be prepared to play major scales up to 2 sharps/flats for your instrument and chromatic scale (one octave). Vocalists should bring a solo or sing a passage from a piece you performed this year in choir.

Residence Hall Check In: If you are staying in the Residence Hall, check-in is from 12:00 – 3:00 p.m. in the lobby of Grand Mesa Hall, our newest hall. A keycard will be issued to you, which is also used for meals at the College Center. Phone Number for the front desk at Grand Mesa Hall is: (970) 986-3004

Meals: Students dining on campus will be issued a meal card at check-in that is swiped upon entering the dining hall. For those students who are staying in the Residence Hall and for those who have chosen the Commuter 2 package, meals are in the dining hall in the College Center. Students bringing a sack lunch may eat on the picnic tables in the quad outside the Moss Performing Arts Center.

Private Lessons: All students who register receive one private lesson (included in tuition). Specialists teach private lessons, and additional lessons are recommended. Fees for additional private lessons are \$20.00 per 30-minute lesson. Two private lessons are recommended on each instrument. Campers can register for two additional lessons for a total of three. Students are required to bring method books and or solo (s) to the music camp.
