Western Colorado Community College is an open admission, comprehensive community college. WCCC offers a wide variety of certificate programs that can be completed in less than a year, associate degree programs that average two years in length, and an array of skills courses for career upgrade.

Western Colorado Community College is a branch of Mesa State College. Students with housing needs reside on the Mesa State College campus. Full-time students who are single, under 21 years of age, and not living with their parents in Mesa County, are required to live on the Mesa State College campus (provided that space is available).

Applicant Information

To be considered for admission to the college, applicants need to submit the following:

1. Application for Undergraduate Admission;
2. Non-refundable \$30 application processing fee;
3. Official high school transcripts, GED or home school evaluation form or portfolio;
4. If under the age of 23 ACT or SAT test scores required (not needed if applying for a certificate program)

Transfer Admissions

To be considered for admission to the college as a transfer student, applicants need to submit the following:

1. Application for Undergraduate Admission;
2. Non-refundable \$30 application processing fee;
3. Official transcripts from all previous colleges attended;
4. If under the age of 23 and transferring fewer than 30 semester hours of college credit, submit high school transcripts and ACT or SAT test scores (not needed if applying for a certificate program).

Admissions Checklist

- Send \$30 application processing fee (not required for prior Mesa State College students).
- Request high school transcripts or GED scores to be sent directly to Mesa State College (not required for transfer students with 30 semester hours of college credit).
- Request college transcripts, if applicable, to be sent directly to Mesa State College from **all** institutions attended.
- Send ACT or SAT scores if under the age of 23 (not required for students applying for a certificate program).
